# C LOOK BACK

- **BLESS**: How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?

### **O** LOOK IN

- Read I Corinthians 10:1-13. How is this passage unpacking the plea from I Corinthians 9:27 to not be "disqualified"?
- What does the passage say God did for Israel to allow them to be delivered from slavery in Egypt to enter into the promised land? What has God done for you to be delivered from slavery to sin and to live an abundant life?
- What kept them from entering into the promised land? What keeps you from entering into abundant life in Christ?
- What sins easily entangle you? How does Hebrews 4:15-16 encourage you to not yield to your own evil cravings?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
