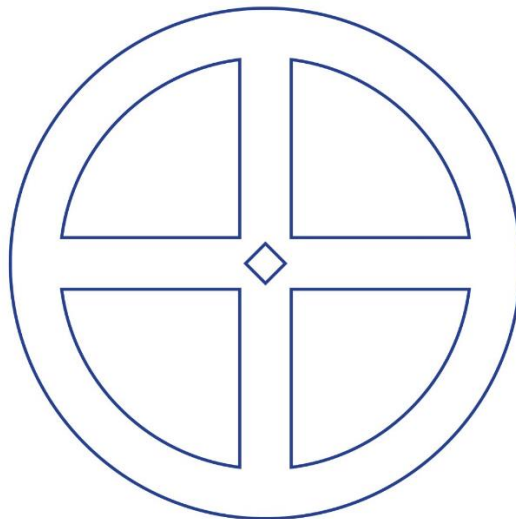

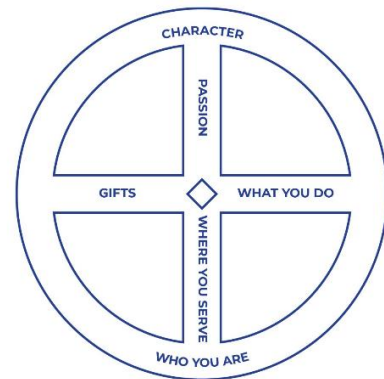
Glory Revealed in Greater Gifts

LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: 1 Peter 4:7-11:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** "Lord, I have been unwilling to serve because..."

LOOK IN

- Read all of I Corinthians 12. What truths is 12:26 repeating? What new truth is 12:27 introducing?
- What makes apostleship, prophecy, and teaching greater gifts?
- Is the truth that all gifts are valuable, but some are greater consistent with the example of the church being a body? What is greater in the physical body?
- What could you do to develop your effectiveness in using your gift?
- Where does your current serving fit on the "serving wheel"? What adjustments would you need to make to be in the middle of fruitful and fulfilled?



- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
- For further study: Read these passages to deepen your understanding.

 - 1 Timothy 4

LOOK FORWARD

- Closing Prayer
 - Requests: What are you asking God to do in and through you in the coming week?
 - Relinquishment: Present your body to God as an instrument to work in and through for His glory.
