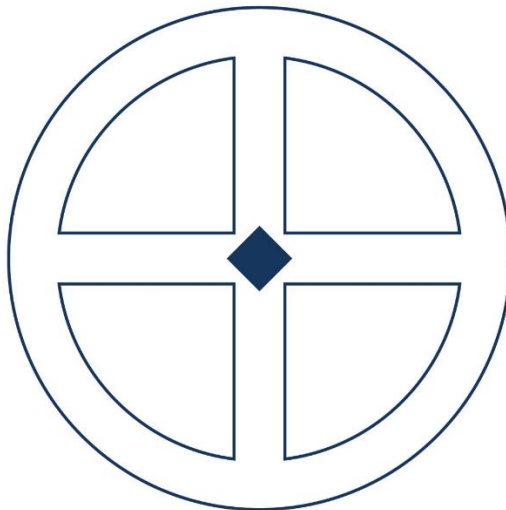

## Glory Revealed Most in Love

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 100:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** Where in your life has the Lord exposed a lack of love (even though you may be serving)?

### LOOK IN

- Read 1 Corinthians 12:31- 13:3
- Write a simple summary sentence of this passage.
- Why is love the greatest, above all, beyond all, most excellent way for a disciple of Jesus?
- How do you know if you have begun to find your significance in life in your work, your knowledge, or your reputation?
- What have you learned about discerning the motives of your heart when it comes to your serving?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
