Glory Revealed In Stopping



- **BLESS**: How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- *Praise: Psalm 32*: Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- *Confession:* Are you keeping a record of someone's wrong against you instead of releasing them as God has released you from the penalty for your wrongdoing?

LOOK IN

- Read I Corinthians 13:4-7. Which of the 8 "red lights" of what love is not or does not do stand out to you?
- What do you think about the observation that the 8 "red lights" alternate between a heart issue and out of the mouth issue? What does this reveal to you about your actions that are unloving?
- What did you think and feel as you listened to Chris tell his story?
- In what specific situations has God's forgiveness of you compelled you to forgive others?
- What would you say to those who say "I can't forgive" or "I won't forgive."
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage
 vou?
