C LOOK BACK

- Review again the 8 red lights of what love is not and what love does not. What are you learning about your heart because of what is coming out of your mouth (or not coming out of your mouth)
- In what specific actions of love do you feel desperate for the supernatural power of God in your life?
- What do you think you will be remembered for?
- What does it mean that "love never fails"?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
