LOOK BACK

LOOK IN

- Write a one sentence summary of Paul's answer to their question.
- What three key ingredients does prophecy bring to a worship service? How would you distinguish these three words?
- Why are tongues, without an interpreter, in the worship service less valuable than prophecy? What is the value of tongues?
- What is the reason for women not proclaiming God's word in the worship service?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
