LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 16:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)

- **Confession:** Are you shrinking back from using the gifts that God has given you for the building up of the body of Christ?

LOOK IN

- Why does Paul call the death, burial, resurrection and appearance of Jesus “of first importance”?
- How might our faith change if we forget that the resurrection is central?
- What part of the gospel do you personally tend to focus on most — the cross or the resurrection? Why?
- Why do you think Paul included such a long list of eyewitnesses to the resurrection?
- Which of the 1 Cor 15 witnesses stands out most to you
- As we built a case for the resurrection, what was helpful for you?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
