O LOOK IN

- How important has resurrection been in your life? What leads you to answer so?
- Out of the list of things that collapse if Christ did not rise, which one stands out the most to you?
- How does the resurrection affect the daily life of the believer?
- What did the life of the early believers look like because of the resurrection?
- What's one area of your life where you want to live more boldly because Christ is alive?
- Is there a place in your life that is not changing even though He has risen?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?

- Closing Prayer
 - Requests: What are you asking God to do in and through you in the coming week?
 - Relinquishment: Present your body to God as an instrument to work in and through for His glory.
