## Glory Revealed In Planning

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 90 (emphasis on vs. 12-14):** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- **Confession:** How have you become a slave to your plans instead of a servant of the Lord?

### LOOK IN

- Read 1 Corinthians 16:3-12
- What do you imagine would be required of a person to be approved to carry the special collection to Jerusalem?
- What are Paul's priorities as he makes his travel plans?
- How can you apply these priorities to your planning?
- Take a few minutes and answer the 5 questions below for planning in the new year:
  1. What ministry opportunity will you prioritize?
  2. What resistance/difficulty should you expect?
  3. What mutual relationships will you cultivate?
  4. Who will you encourage?
  5. Are you prepared to flex?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
