PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS

To introduce and lead preschoolers in a musical experience that meets the emotional, intellectual, social and spiritual needs of an individual and the group. To instill a lifelong love of music through singing and activities using simple instruments.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must love music
- Must love preschoolers
- Previous musical training preferred
- Self-starter, punctual, dependable, willing to learn and grow and energetically engage with children
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Must interact well with others – students, staff members and parents/guardians of students
- Must be able to articulate his/her understanding of the Christian faith in terms of a child's experience
- Willingness and flexibility to serve and support where needed
- Heart for ministry and early childhood education

REQUIREMENTS

- Must have received Jesus Christ as his/her personal Savior and have demonstrated a practical submission to His Lordship in his/her life.
- Must be at least 18 years old, have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must undergo and pass background check (including fingerprinting.)
- Must have completed (or complete) 45 hours of mandated FL DCF training

- Experience in childcare or teaching preschool preferred
- Complete First Aid & Pediatric CPR/Fire Extinguisher and PEARLS training requirements provided by Precious Promises Preschool
- Complete 15 in service hours before January 30
- All teachers will be required to attend pre-planning and post-planning days
There will be two mandatory staff meetings that all staff are required to attend

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Implement a program that meets the emotional, physical, intellectual, social and spiritual needs of the individual and the group
- Prepares weekly lesson plans
- Arrives promptly in the morning to allow sufficient time to prepare for the morning's activities
- Use multiple tools for interactive participation in Music class
- Interact and help children to improve coordination, listening skills, and social-emotional skills through collaborative musical play
- Help the children control behavior using a positive, consistent approach
- Provide nurturing but help the children develop independence
- Help the children learn good social skills
- Observe and report any significant individual or group behavior
- Select songs and prepare students to sing at the Christmas Program and the End of the Year Program.
- Put together simple stage decorations for programs.
- Present him/herself and instruction of children in a manner consistent with the philosophy of Christian Family Chapel
- Continuously strive to achieve the goals of Precious Promises Preschool
- Model kindness, respect and Christlikeness
- Attend staff meetings and required training courses
- Other duties as assigned

ACCOUNTABILITY

Performance will be evaluated and reviewed after 90 days and annually by the Director of Precious Promises Preschool. The Music teacher will be responsible and subject to the Preschool Staff Manual provided by the Director.
