Be an Example: Faith

LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** Whether you took advantage of the opportunity or not, did you have opportunities this week to share your faith story or to share the gospel with someone?
- **Praise: Psalm 65:** Give praise for His faithfulness.
- **Confession:** Where was your faith absent as demonstrated by disobedience, lack of trust or discontentment?

LOOK IN

- Read 1 Timothy 4:12
- Paul encouraged Timothy not to let people look down on him because of his youth. Is there a reason you think people may be tempted to look down on you and hinder your example “of a believer?”
- What truths about the content of our Christian faith were impactful to you this week? Think:
 - Faith of our salvation (justification).
 - Faith of the Christian life (progressive sanctification)
 - Faith of our future (glorification).
- Who has been an example of Christian faith in your life? How did this person’s example encourage you?
- Currently, to whom is it important that you are “an example of those who believe”?
- Manifestations of our faith will be seen in our worship, obedience, trust, and contentment. In which of these areas do you have the most room for growth? Pick one.
 - What sinful thinking and actions do you need to put off in order to grow?
 - What renewed thinking and behavior do you need to put on in order to grow?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
