WEEK 1 Jesus cares about our priorities. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Phillipians 3:8 What should be our top priority?	Play a game of “Would You Rather ...” to learn about your family members’ priorities.	PSALM 139:1 Whom should we go to first with our anxieties?	Generate a family priority list. Pray over it and make sure it aligns with God and His Word.	Ask everyone in the family to list one family activity they want to do by the end of the month. READ TOGETHER: Luke 12:13-21, 32-34 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 2 Jesus knows our fears. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Philipians 4:6-7 How can God help us when we are afraid?	Fear Charades. Have each family member act out something they are afraid of and have the rest of the family guess the fear.	PSALM 139:1 What does this teach us about God?	Do something a little scary as a family, like a rock climbing wall. Discuss how kids can deal with fear in their lives.	Each person shares three statements about themselves; one is false. Guess which is false. READ TOGETHER: Matthew 16:13-23 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 Jesus knows what we’ve done and loves us. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Romans 5:7-8 How does God feel about us?	Role play different scenarios of conflicts that happen in your family. Act out a unforgiving and forgiving response. Talk about the difference.	PSALM 139:1 What do you think it means that God searches us?	Have each family member confess something they have done wrong. Then express love and forgiveness to each person.	Look up different phobias and have everyone guess the fear. READ TOGETHER: Matthew 14:22-33. DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 Jesus wants us to know Him. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Romans 10:9-10 How can you have a relationship with Jesus?	Have each person fill in the blank: Jesus is _____. Go around your family a few times discussing who Jesus is to each of them.	PSALM 139:1 How does God knowing you affect you?	Parents: Share how you came to know Jesus. Ask your kids if they know or want to know Jesus. Then discuss how they can grow their relationship with Jesus.	Discuss anything that needs prayer for the following week and pray for each other as a family. READ TOGETHER: Mark 10:46-52 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?



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
